

**MOZAMBIQUE OPPORTUNITY! SEPT 20-30, 2010**  
**PLAINS GAME OR BUFFALO OR BOTH!**



**GREAT OPPORTUNITY!** Butch hunted this outfitters' several million acre concession in October 2009 with 4 of his clients with great success. We currently have a client booked for Sept 20-26 for a 7 day plains game hunt, but it appears he is a solo hunter now, and the outfitter had some cancellations for the same time frame. As a result, we have openings for up to 5 people, who may all take plains game or buffalo; **NOTE:** We have **ONLY** two remaining buffalo allocations. This is an area where we feel you can legitimately do a 2X1 Buffalo hunt with almos sure success. A full seven day 2X1 buffalo hunt including trophy fee is only \$9000. That is a full 7 days of hunting!



You will head into East Africa hunting several millions very wild acres. You will stay in the traditional tented camp with very comfortable en suite cement showers and baths. Craig Boddington just returned from this hunt a couple months ago. This camp is one of the best equipped Butch has seen, with numerous safari vehicles, ARGO's, two planes and a helicopter! Butch overflow much of the area and saw herds of hundreds of buffalo, plus elephant (no remaining quota). The area has some of the best sable hunting we have seen, with daily sightings of 20 to 100 sable. In addition we saw dozens of great Nyala (Butch took a 29.5 inch Nyala); including over 20 bulls in a single evening! We saw reedbuck by the hundreds, Chobe bushbuck, Red Duiker, blue duiker, Suni, Bushpig, Waterbuck, Oribi, Warthogs galore, baboons by the dozens, croc, hippo and more! This place is a paradise for the plains game hunter, with many species not easily located elsewhere, and all in excellent quantities. You absolutely will see a ton of game here! And the pricing is very good, with sable being a real bargain in our opinion!

**NOW-** you ask about the buffalo? This area borders the giant Mozambique Buffalo Preserve, where no hunting is allowed! As a result, herds of up to a thousand buffalo have been seen on this outfitters concession. We flew the area, and commonly saw a dozen or more herds of buffalo, each with 20 to 100 head, in an hour or so of flying!

There are two ways to hunt buff here. You can hunt the Swamp, which in September will be relatively dry. You will stay at a fly camp, then up early, into the ARGO's and off thru 12 foot high grass until you hit the more open areas. Be prepared to surprise a buff or an elephant at close quarters! On arrival, you will normally be into stalks on buffalo within a half hour! Typically, one day is sufficient to kill a good buff in the swamps adjacent to the great Zambezi River! You may even see elephants will stalking buff as we did.

The second way to hunt buff is in the forest. Be prepared to walk 5 miles or more per day. They will pace themselves to you, but stalking can be a vigorous pursuit. Very exciting, and you will see much other game at the same time. We think normally you should take a buff in about 3 days in the forest, perhaps much less.

This area is as remote as anyplace that exists in Africa, but its pricing is far better than places like Tanzania or Botswana or Zambia. You will fly about 1.5 hours from Beira to reach one of the main camps. While driving around on safari, you will see remote native huts, and a float on the Zambezi for hippo or croc will add excitement. In short, this is the REAL DEAL!

NOTE: if quota exists you may also hunt sable, nyala, croc, red duiker, blue duiker, suni, oribi, warthog, bush-pig, baboon, reedbuck and bushbuck. Each specie requires both a license and a fee. If you wish to do that, we suggest the 10 day buffalo hunt.
